Governance of the organisation is provided by a National Executive Committee which is elected on a regional basis.

Rules and policy are considered by an annual conference in September each year, informed by the publication of an annual report.

The national headquarters of NARPO are in Wakefield where staff are available to assist members on a wide range of topics and enquiries.
