CORONAVIRUS COVID-19 UPDATE

Due to the current Coronavirus COVID-19 pandemic, the Police Treatment Centres has taken the difficult decision to close both of our centres, St Andrews & Castlebrae, effective from midday Friday 20th March until further notice.

All future bookings for both centres, for either the Physiotherapy Programme and Psychological Wellbeing Programme will also be suspended, and no further bookings will be taken for the foreseeable future.

All hospitality bookings, including Bed and Breakfast, Health and Wellbeing Weekends, Meetings and St George's House, will also be suspended for a period of three months. This will be reassessed as the situation changes and if we are able to re-commence any earlier than this, then we will do so.

The safety of our Patients, Guests and staff is paramount, and we apologise for any inconvenience that the closure may cause.

We are currently monitoring the situation as it develops on a daily basis and look forward to resuming the full range of services at the earliest opportunity.

Please can we ask you to not ring either centre at this time, and instead please monitor our website for further updates.
